Chloe Rudd from Print DNA, South Australia and ex Renmark High School student has won the \$15,000 Visual Connections – Lithographic Institute of Australia national scholarship prize awarded at the Queensland 2017 PICA gala in Brisbane.

The national biennial award winners were selected from a field of ten finalists who had already won the Graduate of the Year award for their respective states in 2016 and 2017.

Chloe completed her 4 year apprenticeship in only 2 years, 4 months at Print DNA, located in Renmark, and is active in her community promoting print as a career path to high school students.

"I was a bit nervous, but it is all part of the process. Three years ago, I was sitting with Ian Andrews, Print DNA owner, having my job interview, so I have come a long way."

As for what's next, Chloe says, "I have a business plan, including what I want to do with the scholarship: business marketing, digital marketing, web development, leadership and

management as well as visiting Vietnam to see a packaging and label factory." Not slowing down, Chloe is also nominated for a Worldskills Award, and may potentially end up in Sydney to compete at the national-level event.

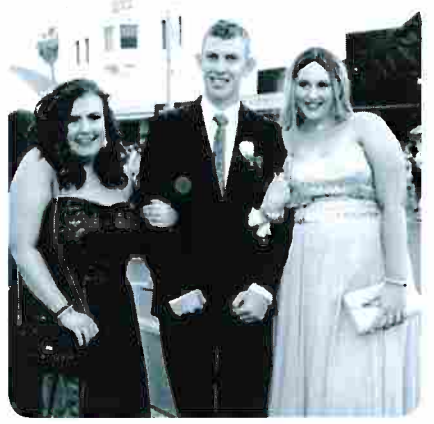
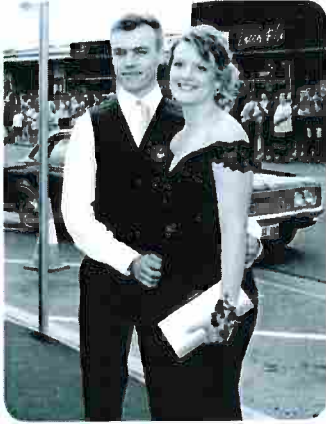
