Daymap and Daymap Connect

Daymap is Renmark High Schools web based School Management System. Through Daymap we manage student attendance, student learning and assessment tasks, student reporting, student notes and records and communication. Daymap also has a Parent Portal feature, **Daymap Connect**, through which parents can access information on their child's attendance, learning progress and receive and respond to messages from the school and teachers.

How to access Daymap Connect

1. Browser System Requirements

Internet Explorer 9 or above, Safari, Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox

2. Setting up an account

The first thing we require is a valid email address as this is what links you to your children's information stored in Daymap. All your children can be accessed from the same account.

➤ Send your name and children's names by email and with the email address you wish to use to access Daymap Connect to : dl.0794.info@schools.sa.edu.au

➤ We will update or record your email address and email you back with the Student ID of one of your children; this is required to set up your account. You can access information for all of your children from the one account.

- Go to <http://renmarkhs.daymap.net/DaymapConnect>
 - Select – 'cant access your account'
 - Enter your user name (email address) and the student ID code
 - Press 'Reset password'
 - After resetting your password please check your email for a code, sent from noreply@daymap.net it will be something along the lines of PRIT00 **this code will become your username** with the new password you reset it to.

➤ From here you can access a range of information about your children's attendance and learning progress and receive messages from teachers and the school.

We hope you enjoy your experience of Daymap Connect. We believe it is an important tool for strengthening the partnership between students, parents and the school.

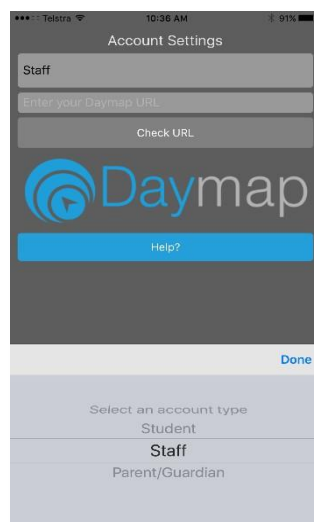

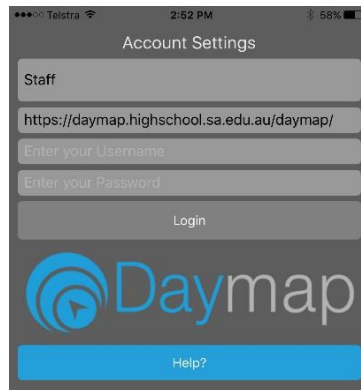

Daymap Mobile App

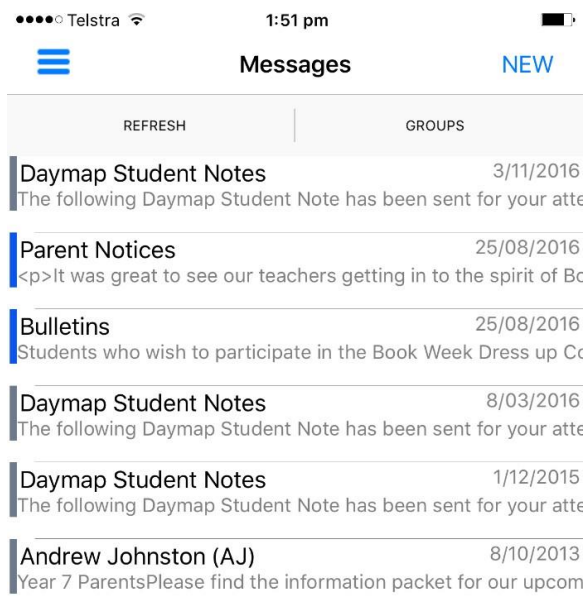
- Daymap also provide a free mobile app for both Android and iPhone users.
- For iPhones ensure you have a minimum of IOS 8.2 and search **Daymap Connect** in the App store. Android users require at least 5.1 (Lollipop) and search **Daymap** in the Play Store.
- Once you have downloaded the free app, you will be able to log in to view push notifications and messages, as well as swap to the Desktop view to see more details student information.
- To use the app, you will need to enter: <https://intranet.renmarkhs.sa.edu.au/daymapconnect>. It should automatically enter /daymapconnect after this.
- Select the type of account you have and then enter the URL and press **Check URL**.



If the URL you have entered is correct, you will then be able to enter your login information. This will be the same as your login for the Renmark High School Daymap Connect webpage (email address as your username and the new password you have set).



Once logged in you will see your messages.



To see all student information, touch the menu icon in the top left corner and choose **Desktop**
