The Sports Committee (consisting of staff and student representatives will decide the awards). Students may qualify for more than one award. The following awards and general criteria are listed below:

RHS SPORTS PERSON OF THE YEAR

Awarded to the student (male or female) who has had the highest level of achievement in sport during the school year. A tied result is possible where there is no clear distinction in achievement.

CLINT DOEVENDANS JUNIOR ALL ROUND SPORTS PERSON OF THE YEAR

- Awarded to a student (male or female) in year 7, 8 or 9 who has the greatest involvement in a wide range of sports - (a tied result is possible).
- Consideration is given to their depth of involvement and level of achievement in school sport as well as local, regional, state and national sport.
- Umpiring, officiating and coaching can be included in this.



KEN PROKOPEC COMMITMENT TO SCHOOL & COMMUNITY AWARD

The award recognises the commitment and achievement of a senior school student throughout their years of schooling at Renmark High School within a variety of school and local sports.

SPORTS BLUES

These are a prestigious blue and gold ribbon which recognises students at Renmark High School who have:

- Been competing successfully at "A" grade senior level or in regional age group teams or senior teams (standard of the competition and ease of being selected in "A" grade teams is considered in this).
- Been selected in a state or national team.
- Been selected in state or national talent or development squads.
- Achieved outstanding success in a sporting competition (subject to standard of the competition).
